

# THE AMERICAN CIVIL WAR SUMMER ENRICHMENT 2014 SUMMATIVE PROJECT

Your final projects will be composed of three parts:

## **1. Research Paper or Saturation Research Paper**

- Please see the requirements for the paper on the website. Your priority will be the paper. You are not allowed to start on the creative element until your paper is almost completed (75% completed) and you are approved by either Ms. Salas or Ms. Park.

## **2. Creative Element (podcast or video)**

- You can create a short podcast with an interview, explanation, or speech (or a combination of them). You can also create a common craft video (with cut outs from paper), a “draw my life” style whiteboard video, or a video with real photographs, images, and your own narration. The purpose of your creative element is to provide the viewer with an overview of your research and make it interesting (like a shortened version of your research paper).

## **3. Weebly blog** (where you will post your paper, your video/podcast, and images related to your topic). All of your blogs will be linked via the class website.

- Use the weebly website to create ONE blog for your entire group. Your blog must have at least two pages and be visually appealing and professional-looking. You must have your research paper uploaded to the blog, photographs, paintings, or images relevant to your topic, as well as your creative project included on your blog.
